SUBJECT: Selection process for new INWG Commander

1. Col W. Mark Reeves has tenured his resignation as the Indiana Wing Commander. He will remain in his current position until a successor is chosen. This document is official notice of the application, interview and selection process for the position of the Indiana Wing Commander.
2. Officers who meet the following minimum qualifications are invited to apply for the wing commander position:
 - a. Hold at least the CAP grade of major;
 - b. Completed Level IV of the Senior Member Training Program;
 - c. Three years command and staff experience at any level within the wing;
 - d. Budget and asset acquisition knowledge gained within or outside CAP;
 - e. Five years supervisory experience gained within or outside CAP;
 - f. Five years total CAP membership with no less than three continuous years of service prior to appointment.
 - g. Prior to appointment as wing commander, the individual must complete a successful fingerprint re-screening.
3. The application process is as follows: individuals must submit a letter of interest, including a statement of qualification and resume to my attention. The resume should include CAP experience as well as working history and other volunteer activities. Applicants have the option of including with their application documents answers, in narrative form, to the questions set forth in CAPR 35-9, attachment 1. Your application documents may be faxed to 614-575-1917 or e-mailed to ccarr@cap.gov. Unless extended by future order, the deadline to submit applications is 5 November 2009.
